	Valid Passport Must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your intended stay in the U.S.
	DS-2019 Form Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor Status
	SEVIS Fee Payment Receipt I-901 confirmation
	DS-160 Confirmation Page With barcode
	Visa Appointment Confirmation Letter
	Proof of Programme Fees Paid or payment confirmation
	Passport-style Photo That meets U.S. visa requirements
	Financial Evidence Bank statements or sponsor letters if required
	Proof of Ties to Home Country Study enrolment letter, work commitments, etc.
	Camp/Placement Contract or Offer Letter
	Supporting Documents If requested by the Embassy, e.g. medical forms
	Confidence A smile, and readiness to answer a few simple questions!
Tip: PI	ace all your documents in a folder and double-check them the
night before your appointment. Being organised will help you feel calm	

and confident on the day.
